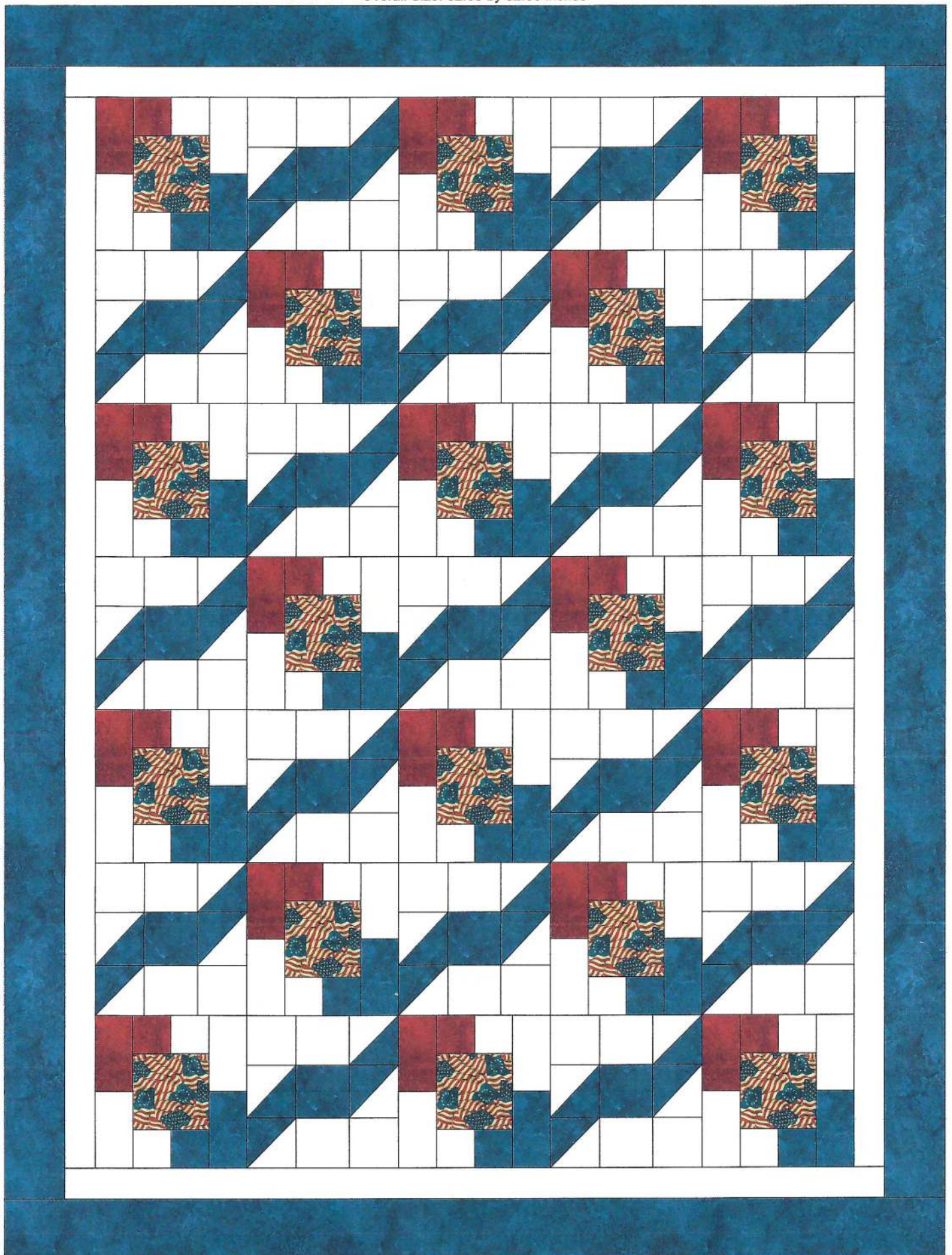


Echoes and Wave

Overall Size: 62.00 by 82.00 inches



Echoes and Wave (**Estimated**) Yardage and cutting requirements

White: 3 ¾ yards

Cut 3 - 5 ½" x w of strips. Sub cut to 36 - 3" X 5 ½" rectangles for Echoes.

Cut 3 - 3" X w of strips. Sub cut to 36 - 3" X 3" squares for Echoes block.

Cut 7 - 4" X w of strips. Sub cut to 68 4' X 4" squares for Wave block.

Cut 5 - 5" X w of strips. Sub cut to 34 - 5" squares for hst for Wave block.

Cut 7 - 2 ½" X w of strips for inner border.

Blue: 2 ½ yards:

Cut 2 - 4" X w of strips. Sub cut to 17 - 4" X 4" squares for Wave block center. Cut

5 - 5" X w of strips. Sub cut to 34 - 5" squares for hst for Wave block.

Cut 2 - 5 ½" X w of strips. Sub cut to 18 - 3" X 5 ½" rectangles for Echoes block.

Cut 2 - 3" X w of strips. Sub cut to 18 - 3" X 3" squares.

Cut 8 - 4 ½" X w of for outer border.

Red: 1 ½ yards

Cut 2 - 5 ½" X w of strips. Sub cut to 18 - 3" X 5 ½" rectangles for echoes blocks.

Cut 2 - 3" X w of strips. Sub cut to 18 - 3" X 3" squares for Echoes blocks

Flags: ½ yard

Echoes center blocks: cut 18 - 5 ½" squares all the same or many different fabrics.

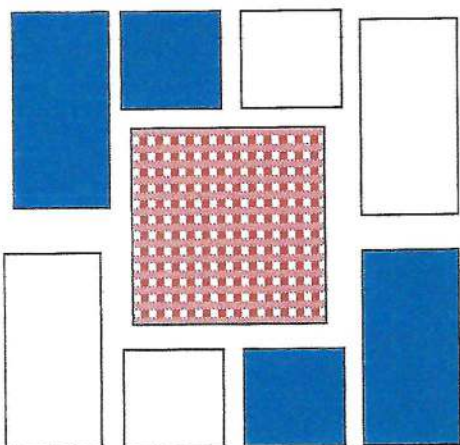
Echoes Block 10" finished block (10 1/2" unfinished)

Block One

Center: 1-5 1/2" focus square (A)

Blue: 2-3" X 5 1/2" rectangles (B), 2-3" squares (C)

White: 2-3" squares (D), 2-3" X 5 1/2" rectangles (E)

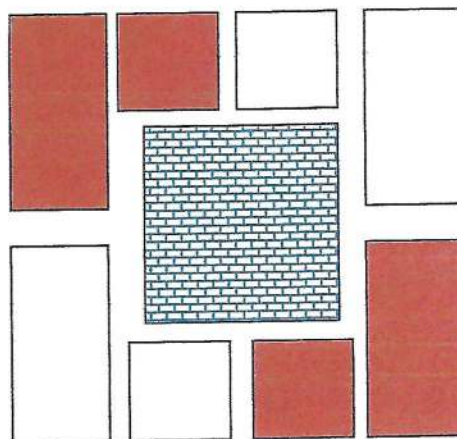


Block Two

Center: 1-5 1/2" square (A)

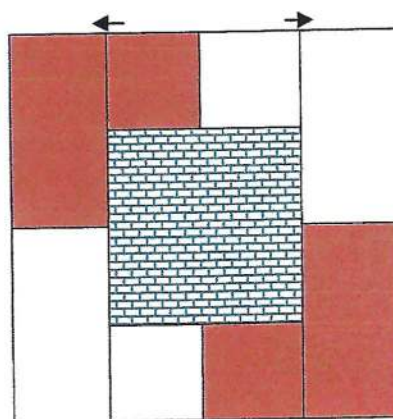
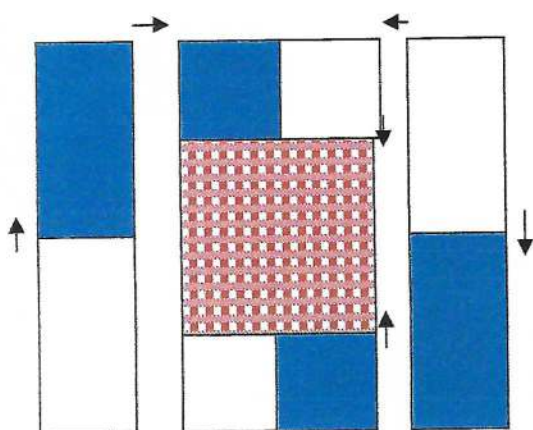
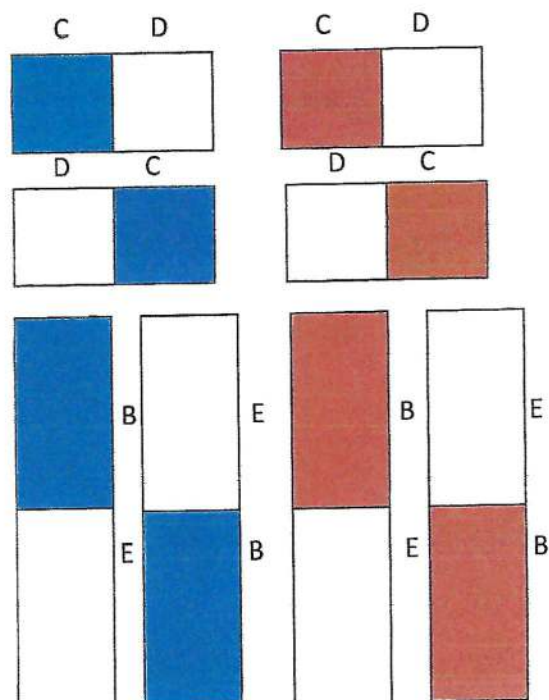
Red: 2-3" X 5 1/2" rectangles (B), 2-3" squares (C)

White: 2-3" squares (D), 2-3" X 5 1/2" rectangles (E)

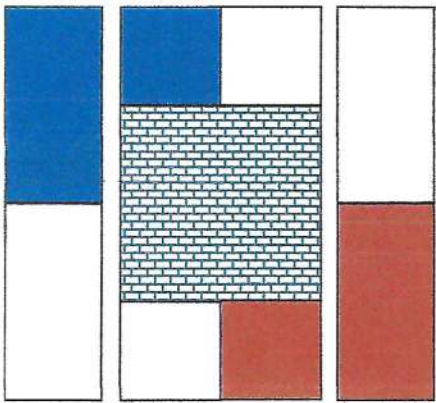


Sewing instructions are the same for Blocks 1, 2, and 3.

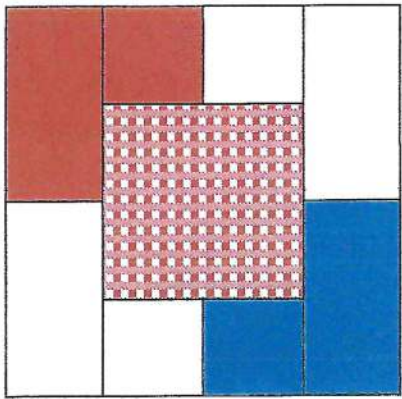
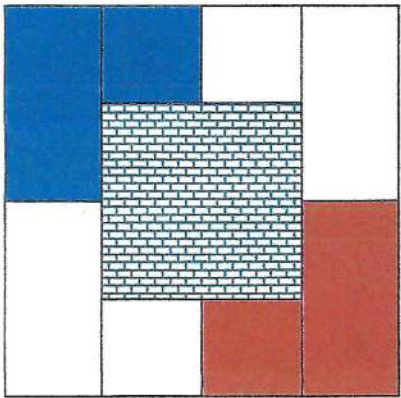
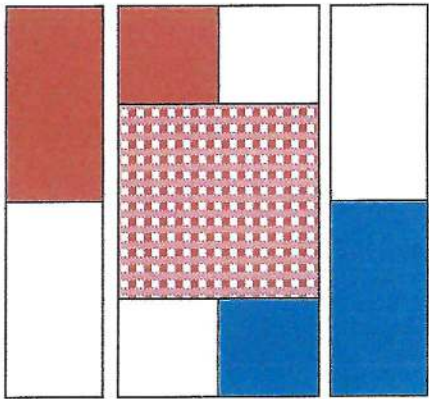
1. Sew one C to one D. Repeat for the other C and D.
2. Sew one B to one E. Repeat for the other B and E.
3. Sew units together as shown. Follow arrows for pressing.



Block Three (option)



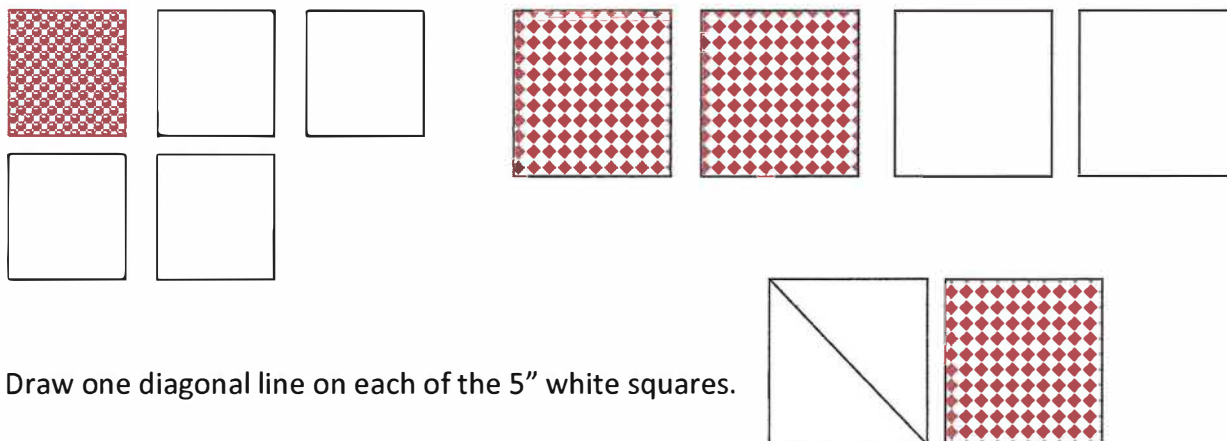

Complimentary block for use with 10½" Echoes Block.

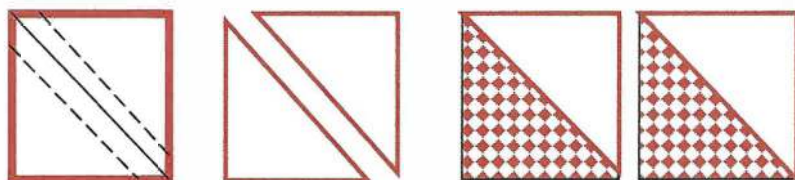
Wave Block:

To make one Wave Block you will need one 4" main color square, four white 4" squares, two 5" main color squares, two 5" white squares.



Draw one diagonal line on each of the 5" white squares.

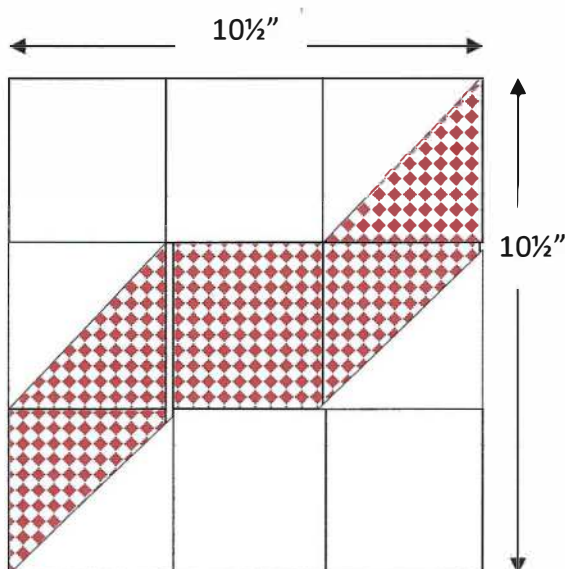
Place the 5" white square on the 5" MC square. Sew ¼" on each side of the drawn line as shown.



Cut on the drawn line, press seams open. Square hst to 4" x 4"

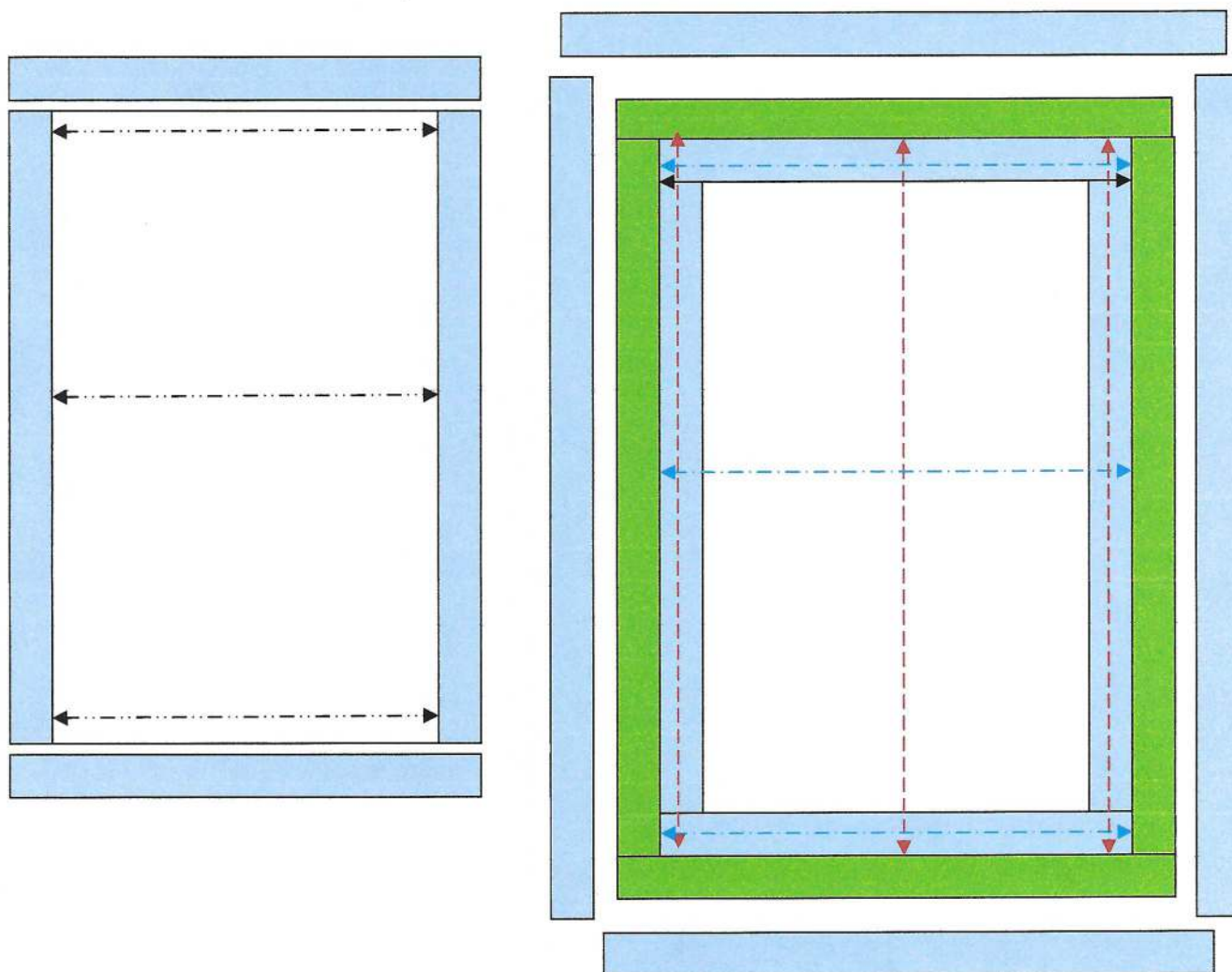
Repeat to make second pair of hst.

Arrange block components as shown below, sew. Your block will finish slightly larger than the needed 10 ½". Square the block to 10 ½"



Adding multiple borders to your quilt.

1. Side borders: measure the length of your quilt through the center length, the length of quilt along the left side about 3" in from the edge, and the length of the quilt along the right side about 3" in, as designated by red arrows in left diagram below. Add these three measurements together, divide by 3 and this will be the length to cut your side borders.
2. Mark side center of quilt and center of side borders. Pin left border to quilt at center, top, and bottom. Sew in place. Repeat to add the right border.
3. Top and Bottom borders: measure the width of your quilt across the center, across the top about 3" down from the top, and across the bottom about 3" up from the bottom designated by blue arrows in diagram below left. Add these three measurements together, divide by 3 and this will be the width to cut your top and bottom borders. Mark border strip centers and quilt centers, pin and sew borders into place.



Repeat steps 1 - 3 for each additional border; this will insure a more square quilt top and less ripple in the borders.
